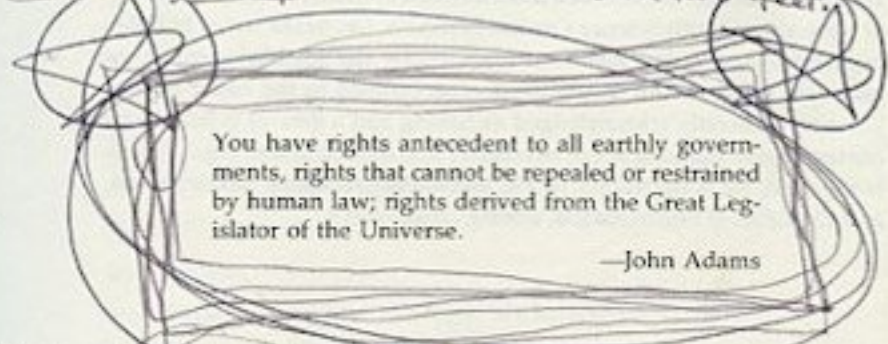
158 Self person knew people would slip downhill/love riches more than rights. The people will be forgotten, rights disregarded
