My friends,

I have been assigned to try to get Steve DeAngelo to speak at the 41st incarnation of the Ann Arbor Hash Bash, which will start at high noon on April 7. We are fighting very hard in Michigan to implement our new (2008) Medical Marijuana law. Our sicko attorney general, Bill Schuette, has shut down nearly all Michigan dispensaries - but Ann Arbor, Ypsilanti, and cities the Flint area are going right ahead and licensing dispensaries. I taught kindergarten for 33 years, then "retired" to finance and run the medical marijuana campaign in Ann Arbor in 2004 - which won with 74% in favor.. We have a zoning and a licensing ordinance in Ann Arbor for Marijuana businesses and our official Ann Arbor Medical Marijuana Licensing committee has just recommended 10 dispensaries for licenses. The first license to be approved was for Arborside (Which I am the president of but do not own). Steve is clearly a historically important leader in the struggles for cannabis and human rights. It would be very deeply impressive (to both our

friends and our enemies) if Steve would come and inspire us and instruct here in Michigan. Possibly on Saturday evening or Sunday morning Steve could speak to the members of the Ann Arbor Medical Cannabis Guild about "best practices" for dispensaries (most dispensaries in town are members of "The Guild"... of which I am the secretary). Possibly the costs can be split between the Hash Bash and the Guild. I have been told that Steve may require first class travel. I know Steve is very busy BUT WE NEED HIS LEADERSHIP AND INSIGHTS IN MICHIGAN! I WILL CALL YOU LATER TODAY, PLEASE FIND OUT IF STEVE WANTS TO AND IS TO BE THE FEATURED SPEAKER AT HASH BASH #41. IT WOULD BE A GREAT HONOR IF STEVE WOULD BRING HIS BRILLIANCE TO MICHIGAN! Thank You for your prompt attention, Chuck Ream 734-395-0811
