 All the religions of humanity eventually flow into the Mystery of One-Spirit that inspires humans with Revelation that carries us beyond the slow pace of physical evolution into the Hyperborean Youniverse of cultural evolution. Twelve thousand year old wooden reaping knives with flint blades were found in Palestine. Eleven thousand years ago sheep were domesticated in the northern Tigris Valley. By the middle of the seventh millennium BCE¹ a fertility cult (religion) had developed at Catal Huyuk in Turkey. The people there worshipped a fertility goddess whom they represented in the act of giving birth to a man, a bull and a ram. The wealth of those people depended on mining black obsidian from the neighboring mountains and making tools from it. Catal Huyuk was a comparatively large and stable settlement in the new age of cultural evolution. It was inhabited without interruption
