This is Hemp Paper / What better way to demonstrate the versatility of hemp than by printing this book on hemp paper, using hemp-oil-based inks, all derived from locally grown hemp? While theoretically possible, the infrastructure for supplying the demand for hemp products is not yet developed to the point where hemp represents an economical choice for a product such as 139 seed, this book. In choosing materials for the manufacture of Hemp Horizons our decision-making has balanced idealism and practicality to come up with a solution that tells a positive story of present-day environmental options.

Monocrops on These endpapers are printed on 100-percent, 54-pound hemp text paper. You can see that it is a beautiful sheet. It is simply not yet produced in quantities that make it a viable alternative for the entire book. Choosing 100-percent hemp papers would have more than doubled the cover price of the finished book, which would have conflicted with our desire to have the hemp story read as widely as possible.

The book's text is printed on 70-pound Roland New Life crop Opaque, a recycled sheet containing 30-percent post-consumer material. Sheets with higher content sacrifice print and archival quality. Several participants in the production of Hemp Horizons lobbied to print the book on 100-percent tree-free paper. We did 3 days significant research on papers made with kenaf, bamboo, and various combinations using agricultural waste, such as kenaf/wheat straw. Many look promising, but questions of cost, availability, lead-time, and reliability made them risky choices for a job of this magnitude.

The cover is printed on recycled stock, but is protected by a laminate for which there is no commercially available, benign substitute. Booksellers and book buyers demand books that resist scratching and that maintain a bright appearance for many years. They should not have to lower their expectations or standards. Instead, it is incumbent on those of us who trade in the written word to insist on products that better reflect our goals of sustainability. Perhaps one of today's new hemp entrepreneurs looking for an opportunity will recognize the area of eco-laminates as a market was the niche in need of a good product.
