

Intro - Without Spiritual Revolution we are unlikely to survive.

We all look for moments of ecstasy and rapture - when we become most human. Lifted beyond original Axial vision was radical - tended to pursue ourselves be watered down by successors

XIII - Modern world - produced exactly the kind of religiosity the axial reformers were against.

No interest in doctrine, theology, false certainty

They pushed forward the boundaries of consciousness discovered transcendent dimension at the core of being

- but ineffable - Essential to question and test.

XIV - required change - effort was to create a new human being - real religion is respect for the sacred lives of all beings.

The Catalyst of Real Religious Change was often all the violence they witnessed - looked within to find causes and found a new unexplored realm of human experience? All found the compassionate ethic worked (Jesus) - compassion less violence

XV - usually had a main god, AND "experienced the sacred as an immanent presence in the world around them" Pre Axial Age immanent practice in the ancient world.

Animal sacrifice - Almost universal religious practice in the ancient world.

Everything was shadow of the divine, Sacred world was more real, they wanted to participate - and be more real.

*Perennial Philosophy - That all here is a pale shadow of a divine reality or - immaturity - That All is Sacred - There is another reality that is more real, > behind this one

AND NOW - we have abandoned the perennial philosophy

XVI Axial Sages - taught people to seek the divine - archetypical within

XVII India - Always in the vanguard of Axial progress

(Greeks) went in Different Direction from the Start

6 Aryans - Made sacrifices and drank SOMA - which seemed to lift them to another dimension of being.

- Benefit of Religion was purely this worldly - material

For Zoroaster - God became NOT immanent

10 - Because of the raiding - split Gods into good and evil - if they will fight - & Apocalypse - & Dualistic

Also - Ahura Mazda - had Montheistic Tendencies

11 Zoroaster was of the old world - but he tried to introduce some morality.

12 - introduced "The Force" - the holy warrior was dedicated to peace.

13 Yaweh - was a god of WAR

14 - only small minority of Hebrews Wanted to Worship Yaweh alone.

15 Chinese Would never be interested in gods who transcended the natural order - gotta find it

16 - In the Soma sacrifice the patron experienced a second birth.

17 Revolutionary suggestion - If you knew all the rituals then solitary meditation could do as much good.

- Aryans pioneered exploration of internal world with samuris effectiveness as being raiders. A Conscious Reformation

18 - Self Abandonment - part of all new Axial Reforms

19 - Hebrew Prophets were NOT mystics - No Enlightenment within. - Smacked by a power from outside.

20 - Amos - First Prophet - Told Israel Yaweh would smash them for the way they treated the poor

Said the rituals were crap - he wanted Justice the spirituality of self surrender - at the heart of the Axial ideals

21 - Amos & Hosea a whole new dimension - Ethical Ritual - Encourage Abandonment of Egotism.

22 - No Greek god was totally good - or cared about morality.

23 - India - There came to be "renouncers" of individual pleasures - Who often returned to the nomadic lifestyle.

24 - Renouncers - Achieved internalization of religion - one of the Axial Age Hallmarks.

25 - The Upanishads - Turned within - Significance wasn't the ritual - it was your understanding

26 - India - For first time people exploring systematically the levels of consciousness

27 - They would discover within themselves the means of rising above the world - Not in ritual

28 - Hesiod - in Greece - said social justice brought us closer to the gods. So Anti Woman - Pandora

Pandora - First Woman - was "Beautiful Evil"
In Golden Age - No gender division (when Humans mixed with Gods) → With Woman kind came sickness and all Evil.
145 - Greeks - Needed (strong willed) farmers as soldiers
Fought as a Phalange at war, Individual glory became anachronistic.
159 Jews - Guy who forged "Discovered" The Book of Laws + Deuteronomy - Tightened up Yaweh worship.
160 - Eh - When he finds the true laws - he first goes off to consult the prophetess?
162 - Deuteronomists, allowed secular meat & secular judges took away Kings power

Through the Narrow Gate: A Memoir of Life In and Out of the Convent
Josiah was cruel to the Deuteronomists.
Went along with it.

The First Christians: St. Paul's Impact on Christianity
They wrote new books for the Bible and shaped it up according to their needs.

163 As they tightened up the logically Deuteronomists insisted on justice, kindness, compassion.

D. - They made Judaism the religion of the Book
History of God: The 4,000-Year Quest of Judaism, Christianity, and Islam
164 AND At the time - None of Josiah's reforms survived his death in battle

In the Beginning: A New Interpretation of Genesis
That their Axial Age began?

180 - in Exile P took over - wrote Genesis & much else laid out rules to keep Jesus together in exile
(1) live apart from other peoples (2) keep the natural world at a distance.

Athenians - Solon - Was chosen as arbitrator of major dispute. Said it was not gods retribution. Peoples selfishness had caused the problems and only real diplomatic effort could solve it.
→ He Desacralized Politics

186 - Talks of Eleusinian Mysteries - Afterward "They did not fear death in the same way again". Did not mention the potion gender expansion Calm Harmony

198 - Slowing of Breathing - Also Produce Equanimity

198 Nothing Supernatural about yoga - developed by atheist theology - aim to perfect natural capacities

203 - Confucius - all "Axial" philosophers - profoundly alienated from their time

205 - Like Buddha - Confucius - not interested in metaphysics and discouraged theological chatter - Brought Rel. of China down to earth. Concern was not heaven but Ego Principle - THE GREAT TRANSFORMATION "the way" Selfishness - was source of pettiness & cruelty.

207 - In order to enlarge oneself one should enlarge others

Confucius - firmly established Golden Rule - Don't others
- so - No Prince would attack others...
248 - Claims 3 Big Sky Gods sons of Abraham developed faiths based on the golden rule? Q Did They? - Islamists today?

253 - Sophists - tried to clean things up - No Supreme god or supernatural Person had to rely on their own judgement.

265 Socrates - Chose to die as a witness to untruth witness
Socrates - was about goodness - and discussing goodness
Indeed - Chose to enjoy a serenity that transcended his circumstances.

276 - Buddha - and me - rely on your own insights - Never take Any doctrine on Faith or Second Hand - Follow teachings only if they "tally with" your own experience.

285 - Talk of God or Religion Not Useful - in quest for holiness - do not lead to peace.

283 - got Enlightenment - 45 years before died.

287 - Luminaries of Axial age became role models / how to live

288 - Like Entheogens - Buddha revealed a new potential within human nature - he was "awake"

300 - When we try to hold onto ourselves we are alienated from the Great Transformation

348 - The Great Knowledge - a mysterious, numinous unity - may be found after we forget about doctrines and theories.

303 - A sage could not bear to see other people suffering

329 - Aristotle accepted Plato's cosmic religion - A real set

up for Christians - they took from Plato
Aristotle knew that the initiates who took part in the
Mysteries - were not seeking facts - but "to experience certain
emotions and to be put in a certain disposition."

330 Aristotle had set the ~~world~~ meat on its scientific
bent - cause another Revolution 2000 yrs. later.

347 - to one who knows the world as his self the world
may be entrusted.

379 "What is hateful to yourself do not do to your
fellow man" - is the Torah? - what crap - it is
rules and killing.

382 - Jews were prohibited from saying God's name.

Axial (+ perennial?) principle - That ultimate
reality is transcedent and ineffable.

390 None are perfect - but Axial Rel Goals are
sympathy, respect, and universal concern.

391 - To Methodically Cultivate a Different mind set

(from the "fight or flee") we experience a different
state of consciousness.

395 When leaders confronted aggression in their own
traditions, they worked vigorously to change their
religion.

398 Displacing the "self" from the center of our
religious world view demands effort.

399 We must go in search of the "lost heart" - the
spirit of compassion that lies at the core of all
our traditions.
