86 - In War only the Generals are running things.


82 - The 5 Circumstances for Victory

97 - Those skilled in war bring the enemy to the field of battle and are not brought there by him. 

96 - Strike voids, bypass what he defends hit where he does not expect you

100 - The ultimate - "be without a certain shape" and spies can penetrate.

106 - war is based on deception - Create changes in the situation by dispersal and concentration of forces.

107 - At night use many torches and drums - in day banners and flags - to influence the sight and hearing of our troops.
