In November of 2004 Scio Township voters passed Proposal J by a 75% margin. A small budget was provided for Scio to purchase land or interests in land, for purposes of agricultural preservation, for open space and natural areas preservation, and to "provide new parks, recreational opportunities and trails".

I propose that we now include only low cost options for active recreation in our survey, since we have yet to procure dedicated funds for the building or maintenance of park facilities. Listing high cost options will unrealistically raise expectations and lead to unhappiness.
