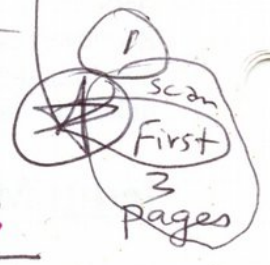


Meeting #2 of Medical Marijuana Wednesday Oct 26, 2011

Postema - Want to accept an "Non Profit" model  
- only model that with worst would be economically viable.

City is in a difficult position - act of licensing can get the city in trouble.

Postema (522) took over. - Says dispensary model expertise could only be done in some sort of dispensary model. POSTEMA - great expertise & collective knowledge out there - harder to do if you only have 12 plants.

4 months may be the wait for medicine Postema - Aspects of the dispensary model

Postema "does have to section" - the idea of the Local Control Legislation. "Local Option is certainty makes sense"

The least division for the state "would allow" the growth of the knowledge - as others see it in operation they may change over time"

Postema - John Barst will shut down Third Coast if they get a complaint.

This Committee can do your work & just wait (3)

Sabra - Rampson will Evaluate - then Committee will get the application for the dispensary.

- Planning will send a summary of the application to the board.
