\* advised REAM that the purpose of the interview was to ascertain his current association with the Students for a Democratic Society and his current attitude toward violence as an instrument of social or political change.

REAM advised he attends the University of Michigan Graduate School on a full time basis, studying sociology. He advised his now married wife's name is MARY. He advised that he no longer associates with SDS no has not done so since latter part of 1968. He advised he associated with SDS only briefly while a student at Western Michigan University, alamazoo, Michigan.

With reference to violence, REAM advised that during previous interviews by FBI Agents, he recalled making statements which would indicate he believed in violence as a means of social change. He advised, however, he recalled that at the time such statements were made by him, he was under great emotional stress. He advised that he now as did he then abhors violence whether it be used by demonstrators in the name of social reform or by police in the name of law and order. He advised that he under no circumstances would participate in an act of violence against his fellow man.

REAM advised that after completion of his studies at the University of Michigan, he would like to organize a child care center for children five years and younger. He advised, however, recent attempts and inquiries relative to the imitiation of a child care center have met with negative results.

REAM advised he has occupied his time during the last two years with his studies and extra reading. He advised he reads approximately 12 hours per day from books primarily concerning pollution.
