INFORMATION:

2007 Washtenaw Ave., Ann Arbor, Michigan is the home of DAVE KAIMOWITZ, whose father is an attorney and is a ACLU member. All literature for the YOUTH LIBERATION FRONT is kept at 2007 Washtenaw Ave. DAVE KAIMOWITZ was born 10-7-58 (age 13) The subject at the present time is involved in starting a Student Union in the schools, recently and on 1-29-72 is an article in the Ann Arbor News which reads that DAVE KAIMOWITZ is seeking \$16,000 in damages from the assistant principle at Tappan Junior High School (article attached)

CHIPS:

CHIPS- Stands for COOPERATIVE HIGH SCHOOL INDEPENDANT PRESS SYNDICATE. The main function of CHIPS is a newspaper exchange, which allows members to see other copies of papers from other areas. Address is 2007 Washtenaw Ave. Ann Arbor, Michigan

PPS:

FPS - FREEDOM, PEACE, and SOLIDARITY, PPS is a youth newspaper published about every two weeks by Youth Liberation. FPS-contains general articles about youth related issues, schools, legal rights, etc. The address is 2007 Washtenaw Ave. Ann Arbor, Michigan

SCHOOL STOPPERS TEXT BOOK:

SCHOOL STOPPERS, first edition and first printing was January 1972 and CHARLES BEAM, of 1018 Church St., Ann Arbor, Michigan, TX # 760-6799 is the person passing or selling this booklet around. It is not known where the booklets are being printed.

WHITE HOUSE CONFERENCE:

A Youth Liberation pamphlet called the 1971 WHITE HOUSE CONFERENCE ON YOUTH is also being sold at the same address 2007 Washtenaw Ave. Ann Arbor, Michigan.

YOUTH RISING:

YOUTH RISING was the first paper of the YOUTH LIBERATION FRONT passed out in Ann Arbor in Nov. of 1971, staff members and members of the Student Union appear on code 508, dated 10-11-71.
