To the Editor:

I am a graduate assistant in the School of Education at U of M. I would be a graduate student this year at Western except for the fact that even though I graduated "magna cum laude" I was not allowed to continue my education on the grounds of "personality traits not conducive to the guidance and counseling philosophy." Now I have been awarded an assistantship at a much more demanding school and somehow my "personality traits" aren't causing too much disturbance.

It seems that something other than personality might have been involved in the decisions of Western's administrators to keep me out. The real reason was that I refused to be treated like a child, I refused to agree that it was legitimate for people like Joe Freeman to have a hand in decision making for the Herald, I refused to be sidetracked into accepting the powerless puppet Student Government they attempted to foist on me. I refused to let them take control of my non-academic life. I learned quickly that at Western Michigan University you either keep your mouth shut or you get the ax.

Today I read in the "Michigan Daily" that the struggle that thousands of us last year were involved in has not died. Maybe now President Miller has learned that the strength of student power and of the movement generally has a moral rather than an individual base. Particular people do not create dissent and upheavals, these are created by an undemocratic, unresponsive

and oppressive institution. It follows then, that the repression of particular people will neither solve any problems or result in any diminution of dissent. The problems will only be solved when the powers now in control implement structural changes which give students the maximum possible control over how they wish to run their lives.

Those who were on campus last year remember that the struggle for students' rights was reaching huge proportions. One night over three thousand students were in the streets. Another night the MCS turned on the campus at a bail benefit. One afternoon about 1,000 students symbolically occupied the Administration Building for a short period. Still, when the end of the year came nothing had been done.

It is clear that students at Western are going to have to intensify the struggle for their rights. You must recognize President Miller for what he is. At the University of Michigan, he would not be tolerated for a week. His drive is too transparently self-seeking to be tolerated. He would either shape up or be thrown out on his ear. The reforms that you are requesting at Western were granted here long ago but only because of the commitment of the students. Administrators enjoy power, their life's goal is a larger and larger sphere within which they can exercise power, they will not give anything up just because the people they control politely request that they do so. Students must not work with the attitude that they are begging

Interview with CRIS ANDONIAN (page #2)

Girls involved with MESSER are SUE CORGIAT and SUE GRUENING and both allegedly encourage high school students to become involved in the movement. She spoke of her involvement in Grand Rapids during Agnew's visit and of her involvement in Chicago. She stated that she and DAVE MOLENAAR broke windows at Kalamazoo Central High School and in April she and TOM SISTMAN stole a tent at Meijers Thrifty Acres in Kalamazoo. She told of an older couple near Grand Rapids named BISSELL who were sympathetic toward their cause and allowed revolutionaries to use their home facilities, car, telephone, etc. (This is believed to WADSWORTH BISSELL of Middleville). She further stated that this couple had a son who was from Washington. She mentioned that RICK DUTIL is very underrated as a revolutionary and has visited with the heads of SDS and the Weathermen. She claims that DUTIL lived in New York with groups that were accused of some bombings and explosives by the New York PD. DUTIL used several aliases and was picked up under his aliases. She mentioned the name of GARY VELLA (presently in jail for defiling the American flag) and VICTOR CAVEY as people to watch. She feels that both could be hard core radicals and should be watched. She stated that CAVEY and TOM SISTMAN have called in bomb threats and have done damage to the men's restroom in one of the local police departments.
