



Legalize all forms marijuana  
for adults 21 or over including edibles,  
topicals, oils, and tinctures.  
Proper labeling would be required on  
all edible products.  
Pipes, bongs, vaporizers would be legal.  
Younger than 21? Still illegal.  
Selling to minors? Still illegal.



Consumption on privated property is legal.  
No personal possession limit.  
2.5 ounces or less can be transfered  
without pay. Seeds can be freely traded.



Protect consumers from marijuana related  
offenses. No police seizures or forfeitures of  
your property or plant materials.  
No probable cause.



Provide licensing to marijuana establishments  
and cultivation facilities. Public sale can occur  
only at licensed businesses. Authorize local units  
of government to adopt limited regulation of  
marijuana facilities and stores. A sales license  
application fee would be \$5,000 max.

10% Tax revenue from recreational marijuana  
sales that will contribute 40% to state funds for  
roads, 40% to state funds for education, and  
20% to the local government where the  
marijuana business is located.

There will be no tax on Medical Cannabis.



### NEW CROP FOR MICHIGAN FARMERS!

Allow for the cultivation, possession, and  
otherwise processing of hemp and hemp products.



Allow for adults to cultivate up to  
12 plants, 12" high or wide.  
Seedlings and clones don't count.  
Must be grown in a locked area.



Preserves current law and expands the  
protections of medical marijuana patients &  
consumers in areas concerning child custody,  
education and banking services.



Driving under the influence is still illegal.  
Be responsible.

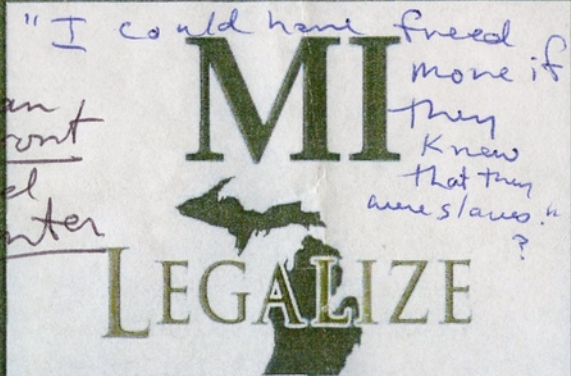

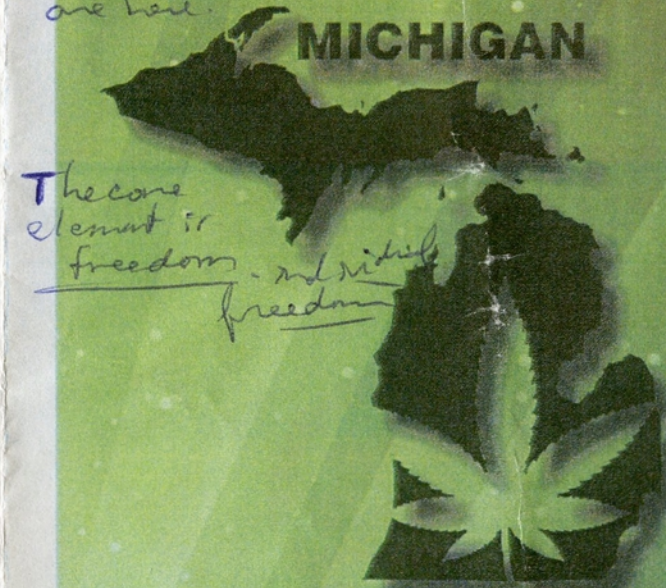
